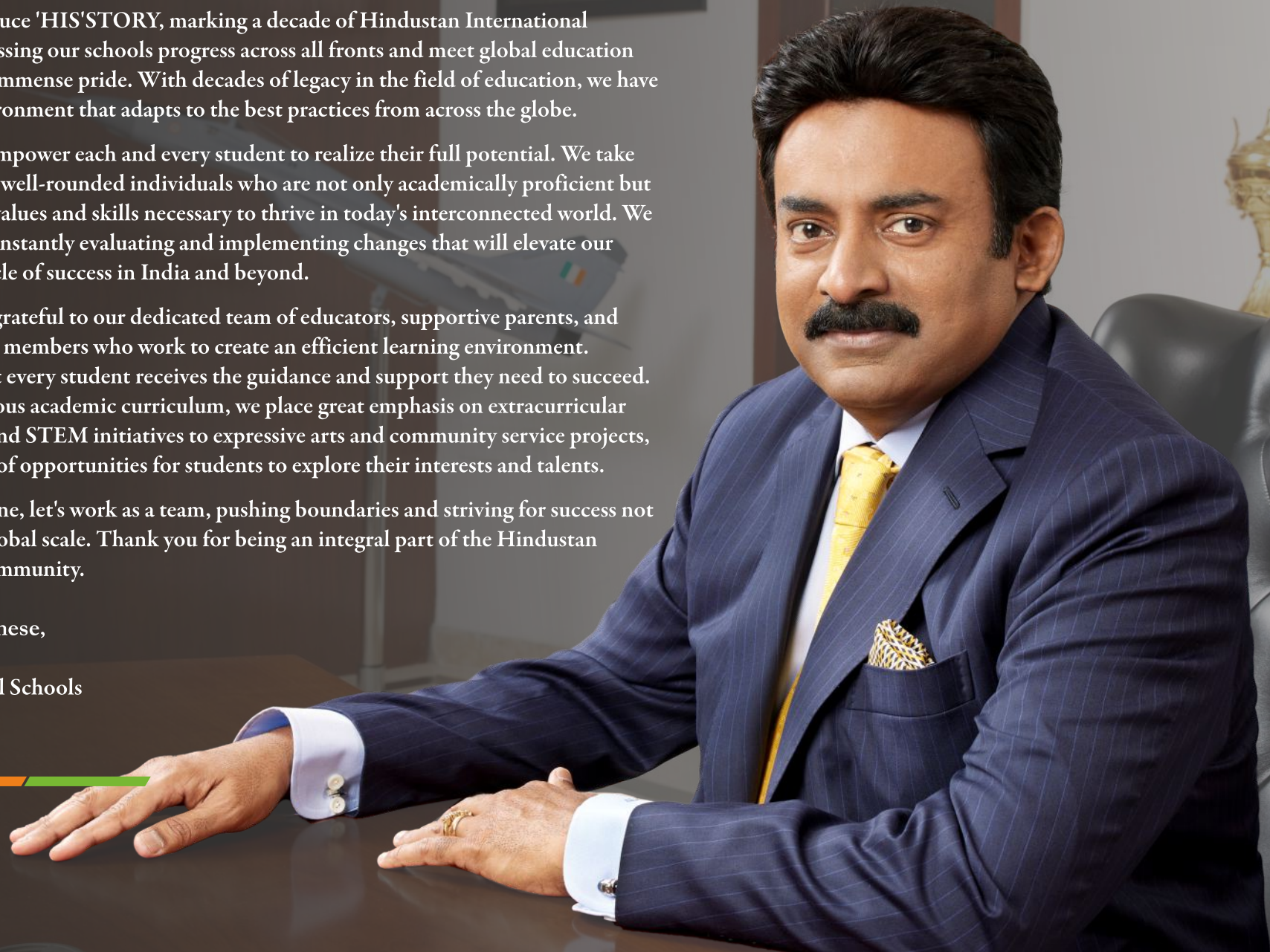

Have you ever thought of starting a school just because you've got a houseful of kids? Probably not in this day and age where families are smaller, however in the early 90's, when our beloved founder Dr.KCG Verghese's father Mathai Chacko was blessed with thirteen children, he faced the challenge of schooling them all, at a time when schools were scarce and education seemed out of reach for many. This lit a spark of curious and unconventional thinking within him, inspiring a bold move: he decided to start a school just for his children! **'Perhaps he realized it was more economical to start a school than to send his thirteen kids to a school owned by someone else.'** Looking for a space within the village, he cut down the rubber trees from an estate for the school building and the wood from the trees was used to make window frames, doors and furniture.

Little did he know that this modest beginning would plant the seeds for a legacy of learning that would endure through time. The legacy carried forward by his son, Dr. KCG Verghese, whose vision transcended boundaries. He exemplified the spirit of a true superhero and transformed his dreams into reality. He was an extraordinary leader, educator, avid aviator, and philanthropist despite being born into an ordinary middle-class family in Kerala, his determination and hard work drove him to become one of the top-ranking educationists of his time. He was a true pioneer in many ways than one, his efforts in inculcating technical and aviation education in South India inspired countless others.

During this period in the mid-2000s, Dr. KCG Verghese's health declined, and he was called by God almighty to his heavenly abode on February 14th, 2006.

His primary goal is to offer students quality education with international exposure, empowering them on a global scale and insists on staying updated with the latest trends and technologies', believing it is the key to success.

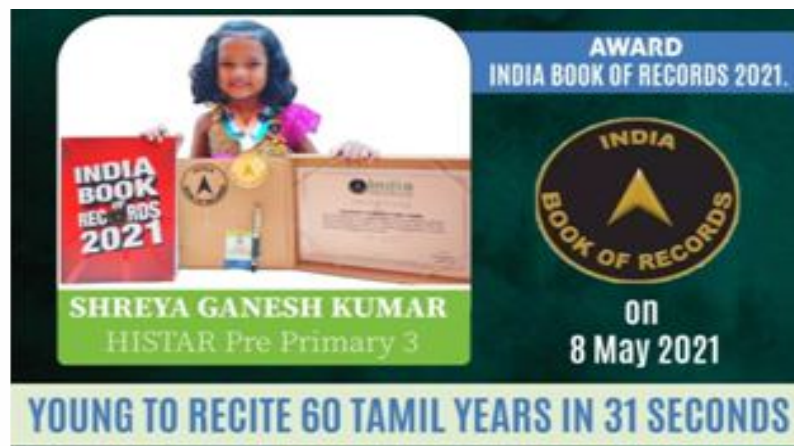
Sizzling Summer Camp

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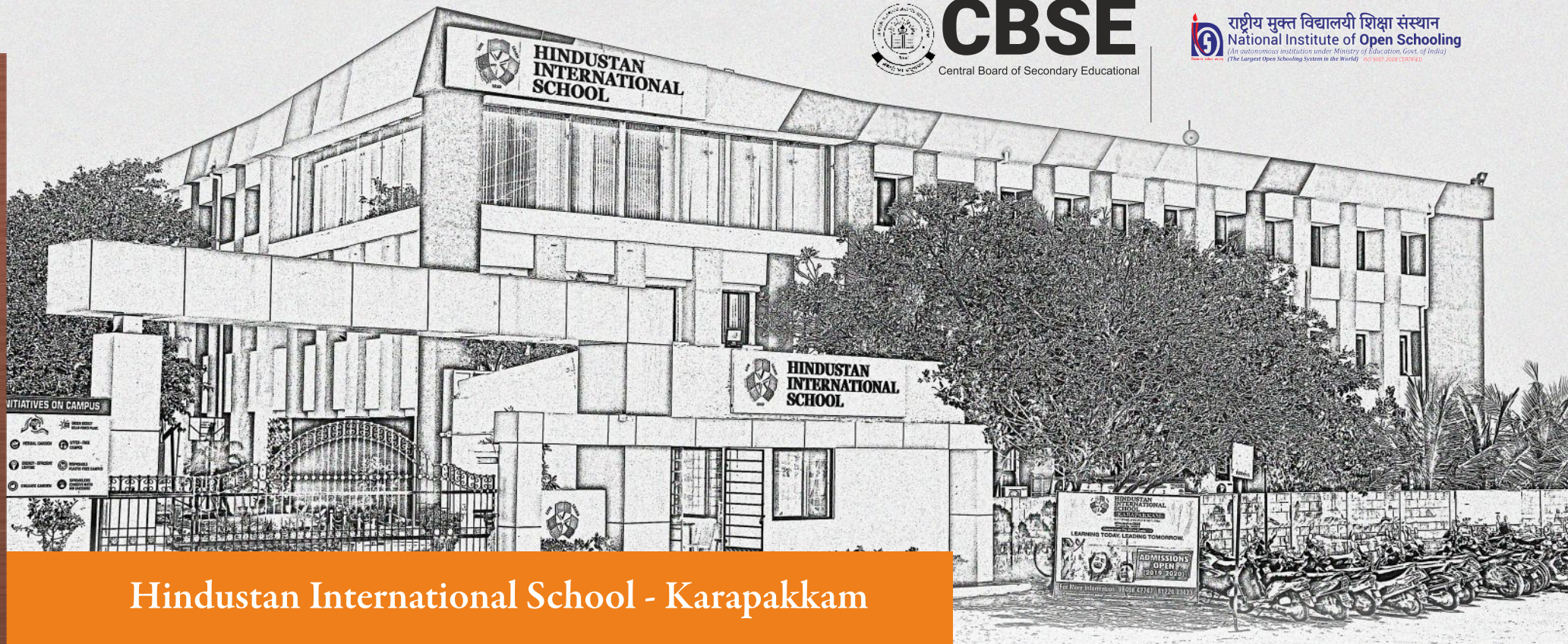
