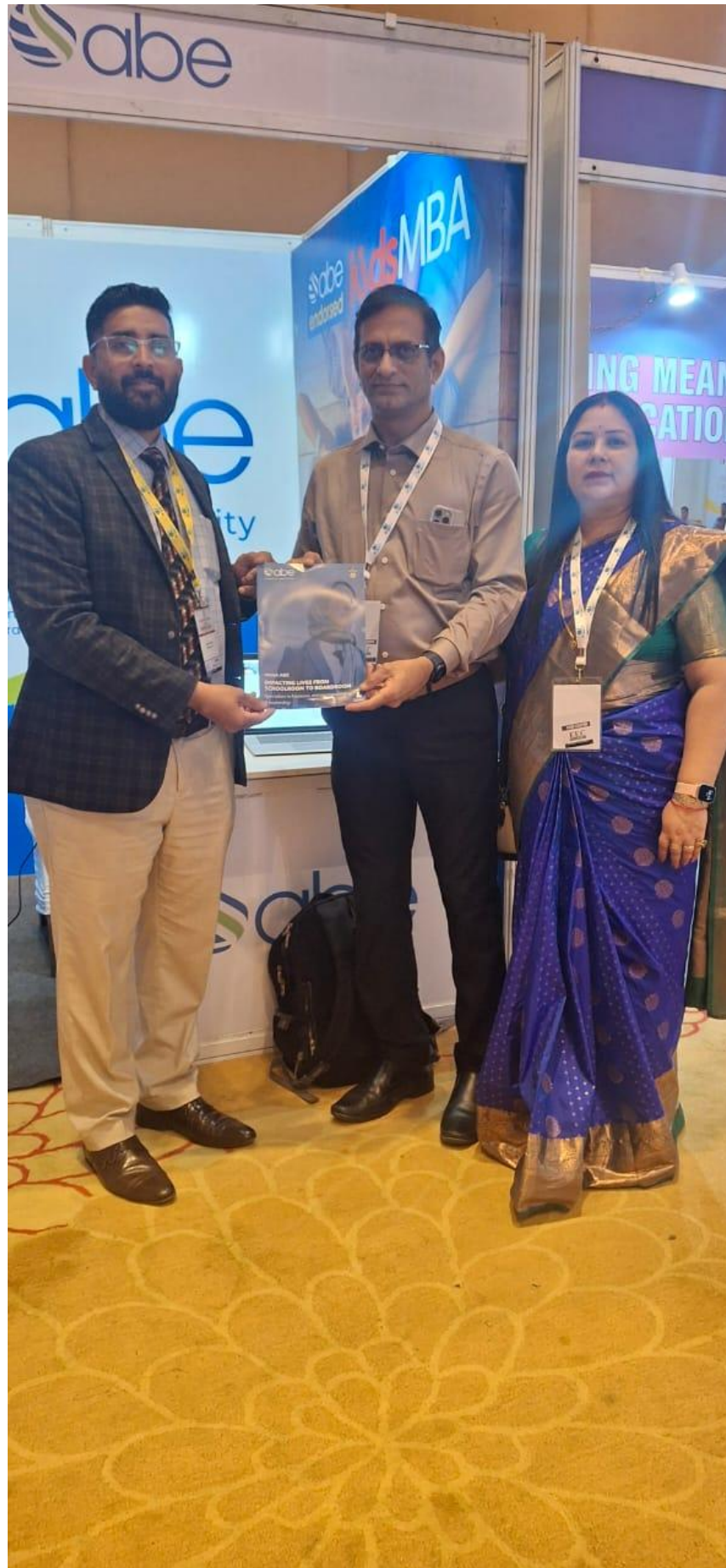

An exciting shark tank event was conducted at Sunshine worldwide School in Goa on 12th May which witnessed 3 brilliant ideas in terms solving problems of

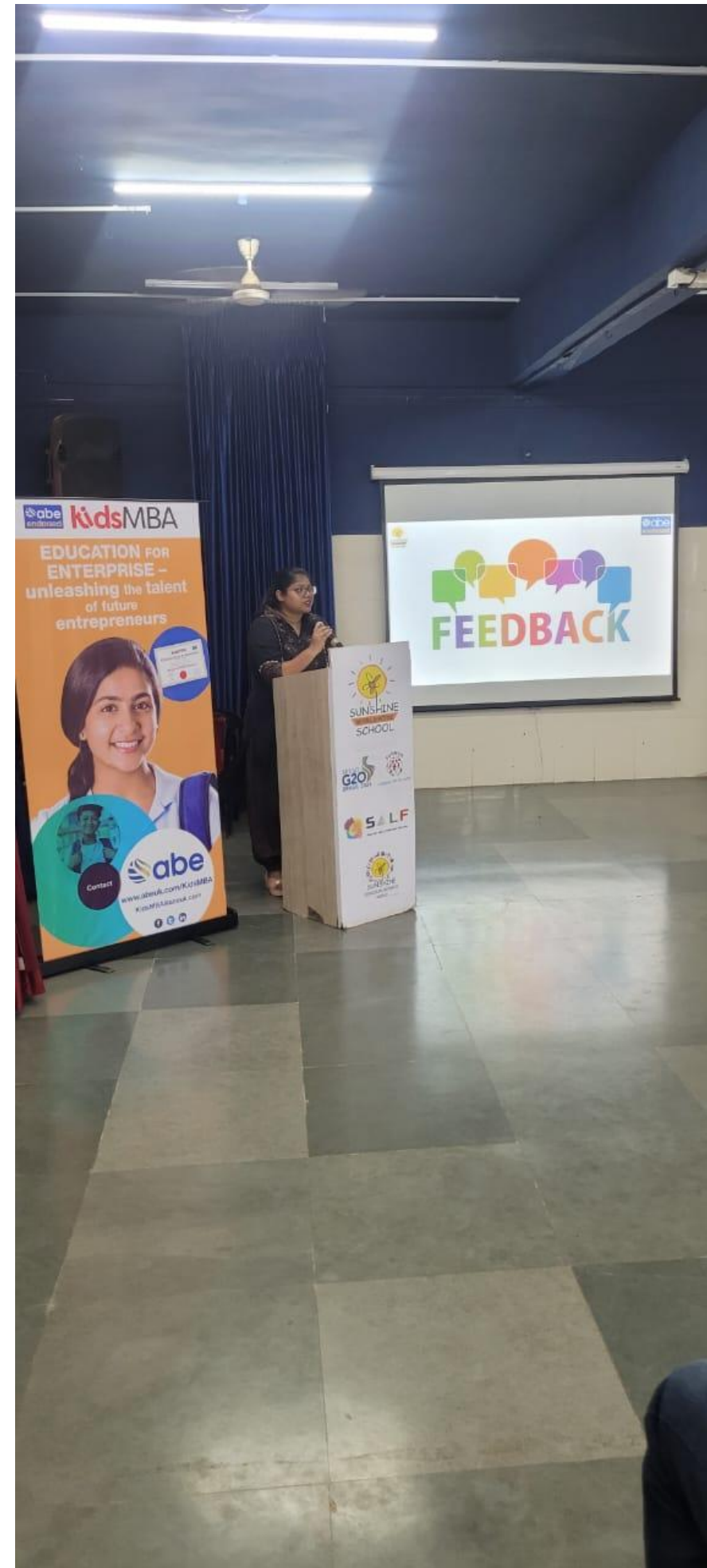
1. Confusion of buying a gadget by Umesh, grade 6
