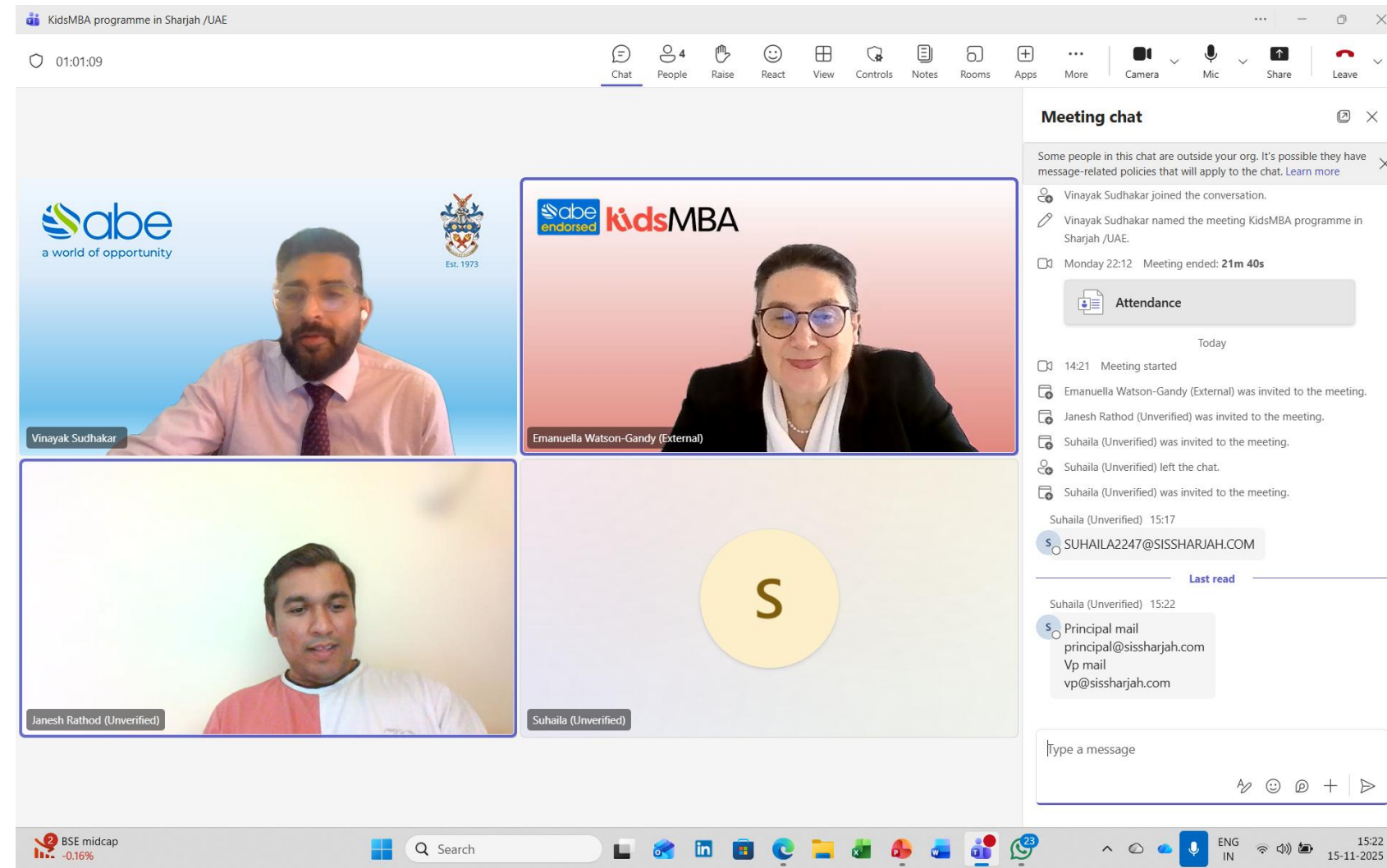


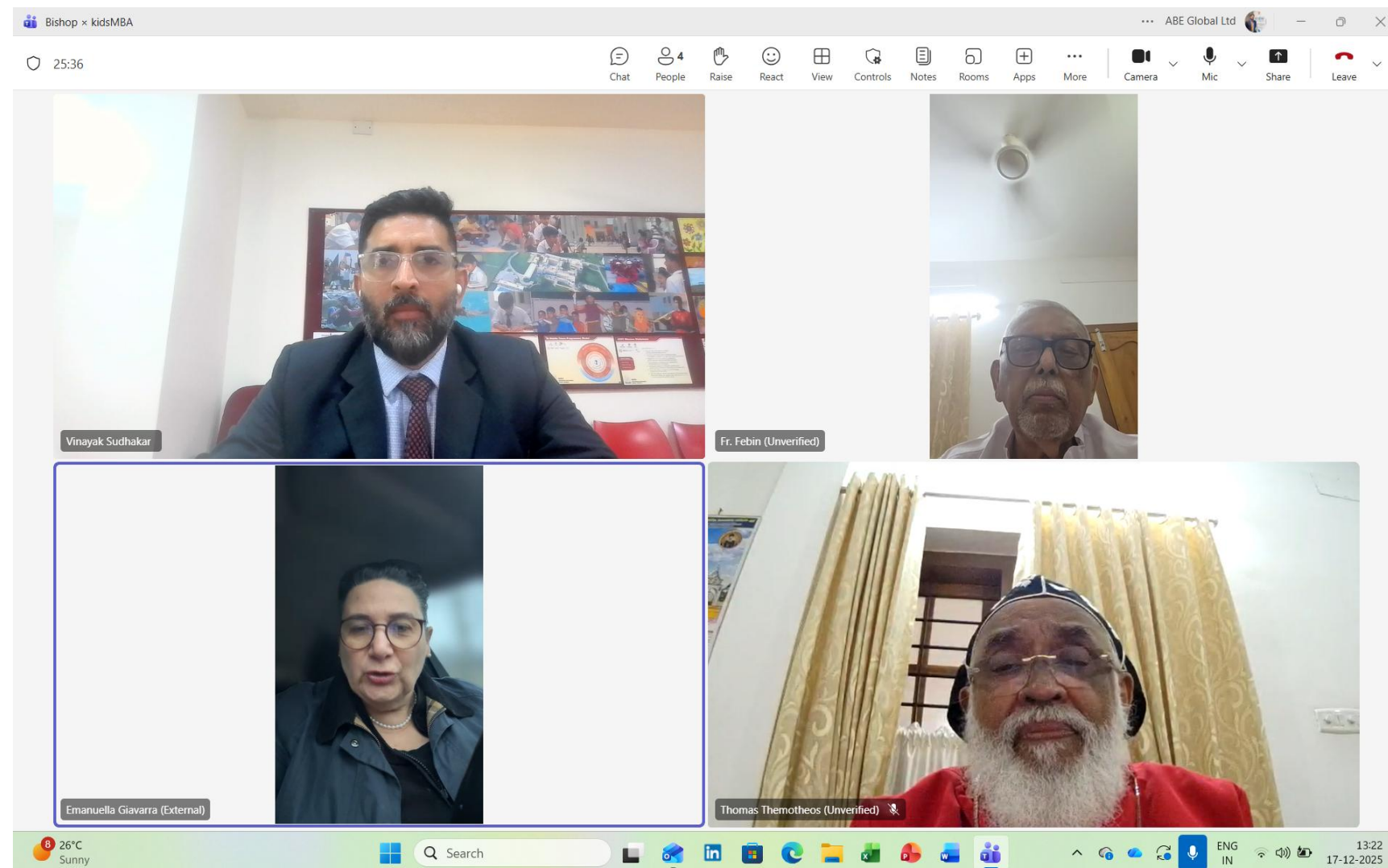
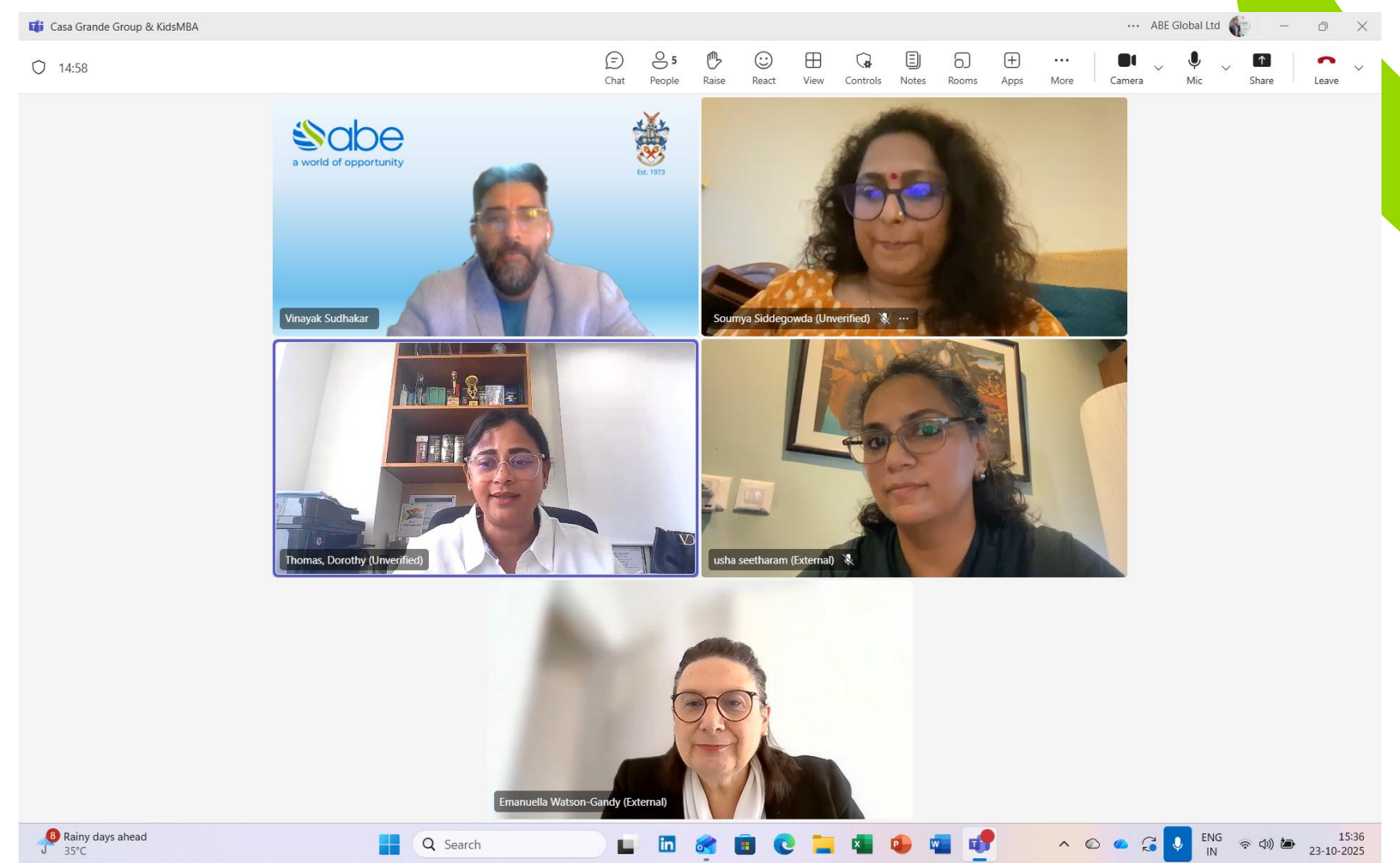
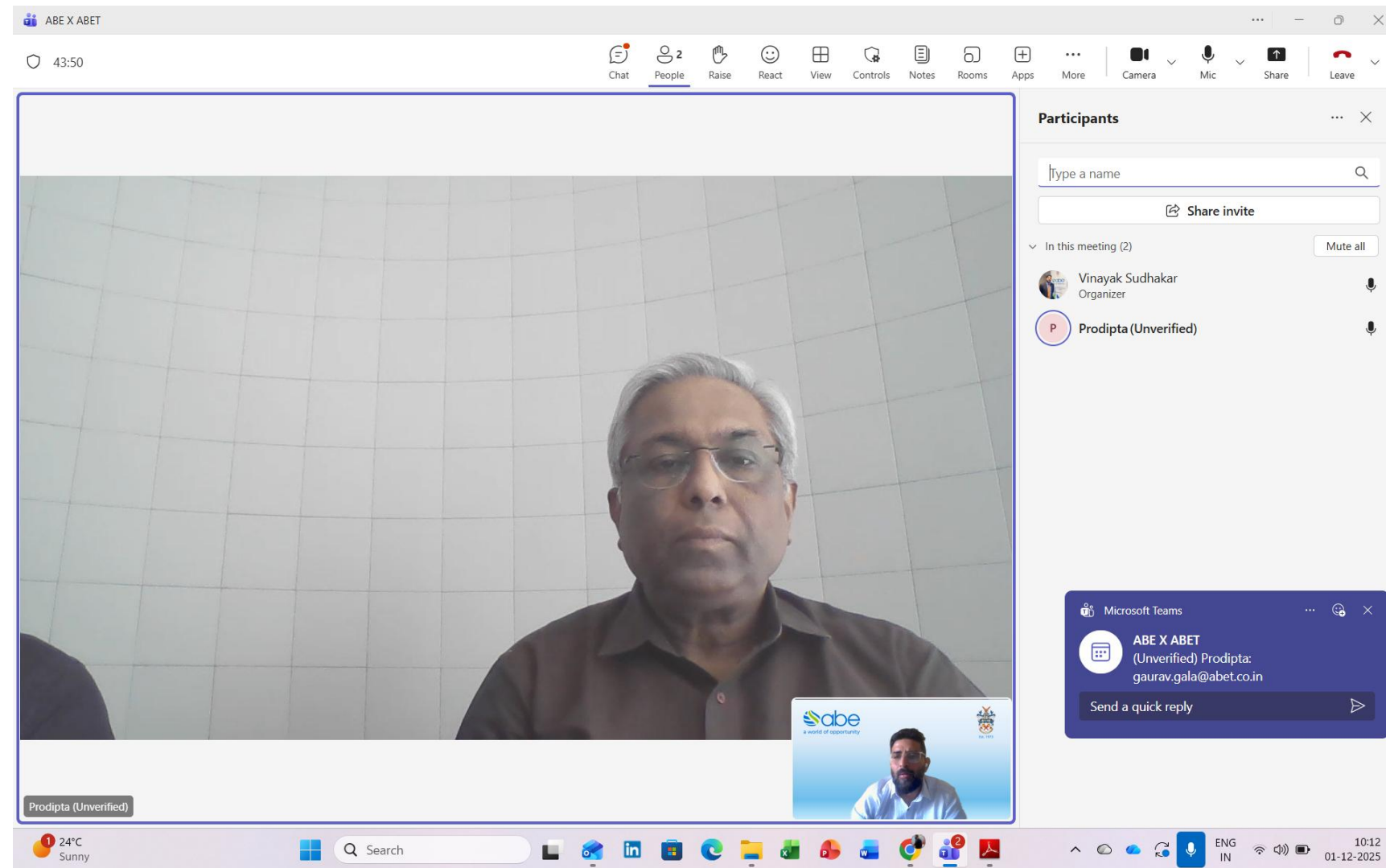
Regional Activities – OCTOBER * NOVEMBER * DECEMBER

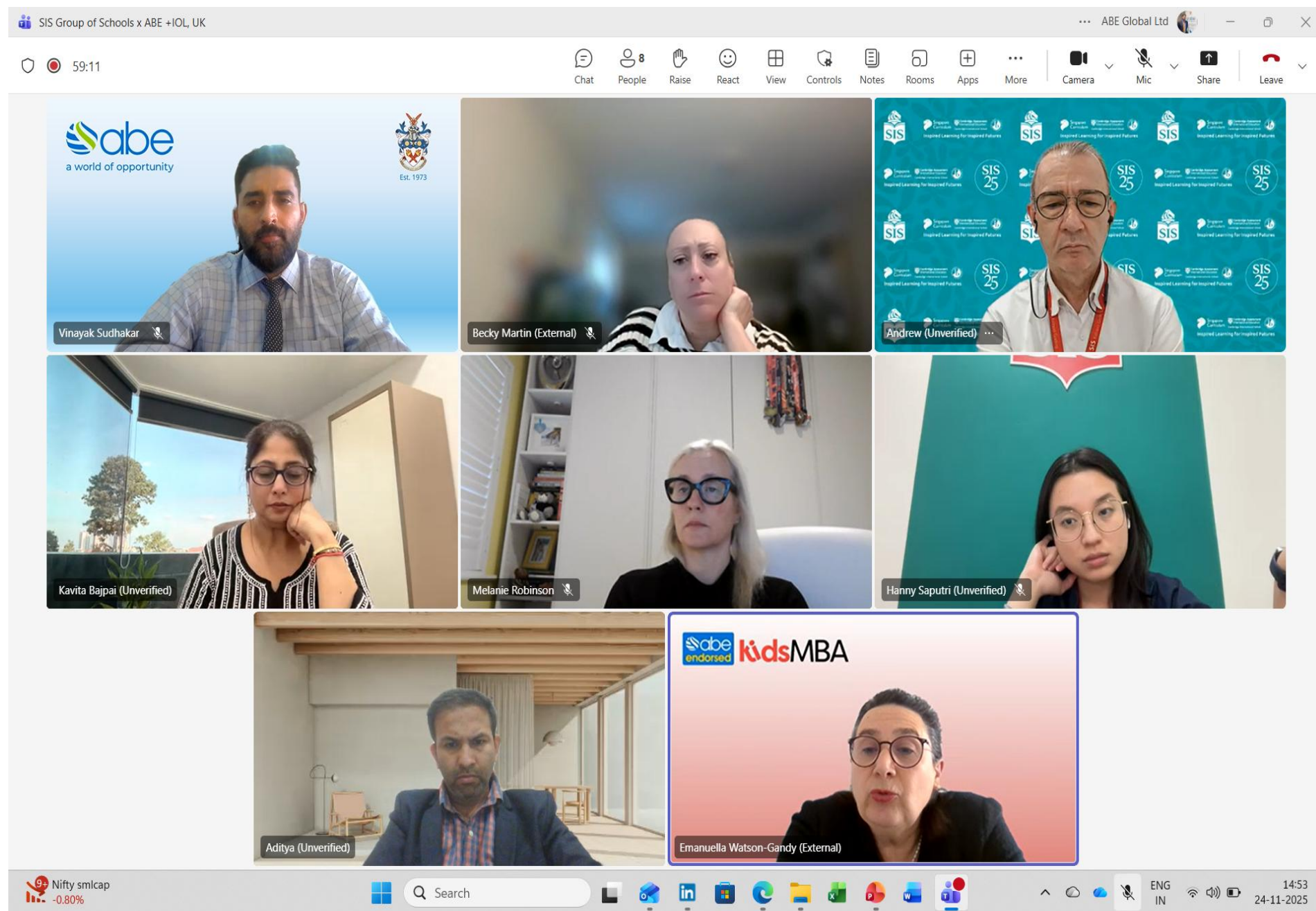
